THE KIWANIS HIT PARADE - 2009 INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION

In addition to the usual exhibits including fundraisers, retailers, and charitable organizations, there will be a section of the exhibit hall to showcase some of Kiwanis' best service projects and most outstanding fundraisers.

Each District Governor and each District Secretary are encouraged to select and invite clubs from their district to participate in the "Kiwanis Hit Parade".

Here are the guidelines for participating in the Kiwanis Hit Parade:

- Each district is welcome to invite up to four clubs to exhibit -- two clubs featuring outstanding service projects and two clubs featuring outstanding fundraisers. This opportunity is for first time exhibitors only.
- Four clubs from each district will be provided this opportunity to exhibit at no cost. If additional clubs from your district would like to exhibit, they are encouraged to submit an application to participate as a paid exhibitor. (Applications are available on www.kiwanis.org/convention or by calling Kiwanis International 1-800-549-2647, ext 261.)
- Exhibits should be limited to table top displays, literature, etc. Each club will be provided with a six foot table.
- If a club desires to have electricity for their display, this can be arranged through the convention center. The club will be responsible for any charges incurred.
- Exhibits can be set up on Wednesday, June 24 between 8 am -4 pm
- At a minimum, clubs should plan to have members at their booths during the Chart Toppers Celebration/Welcome Reception Thursday from 4 to 6 pm. Staffing the booth for the remainder of the convention is optional.
- All members helping staff the booth must be paid registrants for the convention
- To avoid duplicate service projects or fundraisers being displayed at the Kiwanis Hit Parade, Kiwanis International reserves the right to make final selection of clubs eligible to participate.

Governors and District Secretaries are encouraged to think of some of the outstanding clubs they would like to see representing their district in the Kiwanis Hit Parade and encourage them to share their ideas with the entire organization by exhibiting.

Once the clubs have accepted the invitation, please ask one of their members contact Kim Stephenson to confirm their participation and complete the appropriate paperwork.
