Interclub Type

Inter-club – club members attending another Kiwanis Clubs meeting or event Inter-club at a Service Leadership Program (SLP) meetings or event (Note: Host K family members may not be used to complete the interclub)

Interclub –club members attending ---Kiwanis Midwinter Conference, Conventions, training sessions, Division council meetings)

What is an inter-club:

An inter-club meeting is a meeting where one or more club/s visit a meeting or event hosted by another Kiwanis club/s (including clubs in formation), or by any K-Kids, Builders Club, Kiwanis Junior, Aktion Club, CKI Club, or Key Club. Attendance requirements:

- Clubs with 20 or fewer members need a minimum of two members in attendance to constitute an interclub meeting.
- ➤ Clubs with 21-30 members need three members,
- > Clubs with 31 or more members need at least four members in attendance.

Visiting groups shall be composed of a minimum of two Kiwanians' plus members of K-Kids, Builders Club, Kiwanis Junior, Aktion Club, Circle K Club, and/or Key Club must be in attendance (a lieutenant governor can only be included if he/ she is a member of the participating club).Inter-clubbing is a means of supporting Kiwanis' fifth Object, which is "To provide, through this club, a practical means to form enduring friendships, to render altruistic service, and to build a better community." This wider scope of Kiwanis can be achieved by arranging visits between clubs in the same town, division, and district, as well as inter-district get-togethers.

Award received:

The clubs in the Capital District with the most inter-clubs will receive an inter-club ribbon for the club's awards banner

The categories are as follows:

Club membership total at the beginning of the administrative year

- 101 and over Gold Section
- 71 to 100 -- Silver Section
- 46 to 70 -- Orange Section
- 31 to 45 -- Blue Section
- 30 & below White Section

Award is presented at the Midwinter conference for the preceding administrative year.
